Experiencing poverty is a risk factor for violence against women and girls and low income is limiting access to social services, education, employment opportunities and safety. In the Netherlands women earn 13% less income compared to men, and the parttime norm for working mothers adds to women being financially dependent on their husbands. Being economically independent gives women who experience gender based violence options to find help, but women who try to work more and be more independent can risk increased violence.
